General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Rhianna Rashell Griffis (Respondent) because she took out insurance policies for consumers without their consent and took out a policy on a deceased individual. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Allegations mailed by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI). This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Allegations

1. On May 20, 2026, TDI sent a Notice of Allegations, attached as Exhibit A, to Respondent.
2. TDI sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED], Corpus Christi, Texas 78418. TDI also sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's electronic mail address she last designated for receipt of official department communications, [REDACTED], and to an additional address associated with Respondent: [REDACTED], Corpus Christi, Texas 78418.

3. TDI gave Respondent notice and opportunity for a hearing, which Respondent waived by failing to send a written response to the Notice of Allegations within 20 days after the date it was mailed.
4. TDI's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.301; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. TDI provided proper notice to Respondent under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051, 2001.052, 2001.054, and 2001.056(4); and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.1302, 1.28, 1.47, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to send TDI a written response to the Notice of Allegations, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
5. Respondent failed to show compliance with the law.
6. TDI's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.

Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by Rhianna Rashell Griffis are revoked. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

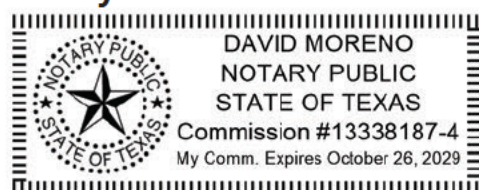

NOTICE OF ALLEGATIONS AGAINST RHIANNA RASHELL GRIFFIS

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to take disciplinary action against you. This Notice states the allegations against you and the relief sought by TDI.

YOUR WRITTEN RESPONSE IS REQUIRED WITHIN 20 DAYS

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO A HEARING AND ARE INVITED TO SHOW COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW. To request a hearing, you must send a written response to TDI within 20 days of the date this Notice was mailed.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, *you waive your right to a hearing*, and TDI may seek disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47, TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055, and TEX. GOV'T. CODE § 2001.056.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, without further notice to you, the commissioner of insurance may issue a default order that admits the factual matters asserted, deems all allegations as true, and orders the relief recommended in this Notice.

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.301; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

Factual Allegations

1. Rhianna Rashell Griffis (Griffis) holds a resident Life Agent license issued on March 5, 2024. She had an appointment with Royal Neighbors of America (Royal Neighbors) between February 12, 2025, until her appointment was canceled on August 5, 2025.
2. On August 4, 2025, Royal Neighbors sent Griffis a letter stating that she had violated her contract by committing fraudulent or dishonest acts, based on their investigation of reports of her taking out insurance on people without their consent.
3. On April 22, 2025, Royal Neighbors recorded an electronic application for life insurance on the life of B.D.B., with Griffis listed as the writing agent listed. Royal Neighbors did not process this application because it discovered that B.D.B died on October 22, 2022.
4. On May 5, 2025, Royal Neighbors recorded an electronic application for life insurance on the life of D.L.K., with Griffis listed as the writing agent.
5. On June 4, 2025, D.L.K. contacted Royal Neighbors to state that she did not complete or authorize the May 5, 2025, application. On August 1, 2025, Royal Neighbors received a notarized Affidavit of Forgery from D.L.K.

Legal Allegations

1. Griffis has willfully violated an insurance law of this state, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.1010(b)(1).
2. Griffis engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).

Relief Sought

TDI seeks the following relief:

1. revocation of your license;
2. imposition of any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
