NCCI Item B-1450—Revisions to Basic Manual Classifications for Hazardous Material Remediation and Military Reservation—Construction—Iron or Steel Erection—Not Over Two Stories in Height

Description:

The filing will revise:

- classifications related to hazardous material remediation services for asbestos, mold, and lead paint in NCCI's *Basic Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance*; and
- phraseologies for employees of construction companies that perform janitorial-type services.

While the filing name mentions military reservation construction, the changes to those codes do not apply in Texas.

NCCI proposes that the changes be effective for new and renewal workers' compensation policies issued on or after 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 2026.

Per Commissioner's Order No. 3142, dated March 21, 2014, the commissioner may issue an order approving the filing, approving the filing with changes, or rejecting the filing.
